CordenPharma Brussels (BE) is a cGMP manufacturer supplying pharmaceutical and biotech companies with clinical and commercial-scale cGMP peptide APIs manufactured using world-class cost-effective production processes and innovative proprietary technologies.

Located about 15 min from Brussels airport, the facility (formerly known as Peptisyntha, of the Solvay group) was founded in 1987 until being acquired by CordenPharma in October 2013. The site has been fully inspected by global regulatory agencies including, but not limited to, FAMHP, EMA, and FDA.
